Why are we writing to you?

Now you are having to manage yourselves and your own time without the focused endpoint of examinations and without finishing your final school year as expected.

What are we offering?

In response to this situation we would like to offer you three things that may be helpful:

- 1. We have produced some **Sixth Form taster materials** for you to have a look at and to work through. This is not compulsory work of course, but it has been carefully put together by specialist staff. There are lots of subjects for you to dip into depending on your interests. The idea is that before you choose/pick up a sixth form course you can have a 'taster' of the subject and start to see what suits and interests you.
