Year 13 - End of Year Arrangements and Information

Dear Students/Parents/Guardians,

We are writing to you to outline some important information as we enter the final few weeks of teaching with Year 13 students. We know our year 13 students experienced disruption lower down school, but we would like to say that we are pleased with the resilience they have shown and are looking forward to seeing them step-up and strive for success over the final few weeks of their A-levels.

A-level examinations start on Wednesday 17th May 2023 and, during this initial period of exams, we expect our Yr13 students to be in school and attending lessons full time when they are not in an examination. This is to maximise the time students have with staff for focused and guided revision/examination preparation. The A-level examination window has been extended this year, with examinations for each subject spread over the entire window. A statement of examination entry and examination timetable for each student has now been issued to every student, it is important that these are checked carefully.

Our final day of compulsory attendance and formal teaching for Year 13 will be Friday, 26th May 2023. After which students will be released for study leave. During this period, teaching staff may request attendance of students for teaching/revision sessions in their subjects and where this is the case, we would expect students to attend. Our Year 13 Leavers Assembly will take place on Friday 26th May 2023 during Period 2 with students departing immediately after this. This is an opportunity for students to reminisce and to say goodbye to fellow students and staff.

A-level results day is scheduled for Thursday 17th August this academic year and will be held on-site. Arrangements for the day will be communicated in due course. On the day key staff will be available to offer support and guidance on next steps.

Finally, we would like to wish all our students the very best of luck for the future and whatever it holds.


