We are delighted to invite you to our Sixth Form Information Evening which will take place in the Sports Hall on Tuesday 9th November 2021, from 6:00 – 8:00pm. In addition to the subject information stands, our Sixth Form team and student ambassadors will be on hand to provide general information, advice and guidance regarding Sixth Form.

The purpose of this evening is to allow you to find out about the subjects offered in Sixth Form and how you can apply to join us. On arrival you will receive an information pack which will include; a Sixth Form Prospectus; an application form; a guide to choosing courses and information about transport and bursaries. Key staff will also be available to discuss the application process and deal with general enquiries.

Why Bridgnorth Sixth Form?

Our Sixth Form is a small growing Sixth Form with a family feel, this means we get to know our students individually and support them well through this important time in their education. We offer a broad range of courses including, A-Levels, Level 3 BTEC and OCR Cambridge Technical courses.

Bridgnorth Sixth Form is a comprehensive sixth form, which means students achieve right across the ability range. Most of our year 13 students do tend to follow an academic route and progress into Higher Education or specific subject routes such as Art and Design courses. They have also been successful in securing Higher Level Apprenticeships at places such as Balfour Beatty, Grainger and Worrall, Jaguar Landrover, Ricoh and the BBC.

This year we were again very proud of our year 13 students who all did very well indeed in their exams.
